What is IP Box tax relief?

IP Box tax relief is an advantageous solution for businesses earning income from the commercialisation of intellectual property rights they have created or developed. This relief is a continuation of the R&D relief covering the creation of intellectual property.

Most importantly, the tax on income from intellectual property rights can only amount to 5% of the taxable base. Poland has therefore recently become a tax haven for those who produce or buy and improve inventions, industrial designs or computer software.

To benefit from the 5% tax rate, taxpayers will be obliged to maintain special accounting records to determine revenues, deductible costs and income (loss) attributable to each of the qualifying IP rights.
